- joint participation in the organization and holding of Ukrainian-Polish / Polish-Ukrainian forums, scientific-practical conferences, methodological seminars, round tables, including the participation of third parties;
- promoting the participation of representatives of the Parties in programs and projects of UNESCO, the European Union and other international organizations and foundations;
- preparation and publication of joint educational, scientific, methodological and encyclopaedic works;
 - launching bilateral exchange programs in areas of mutual interest;

Disputable matters related to the interpretation or application of the provisions of this Memorandum after its entry into force shall be resolved through negotiations and consultations.
